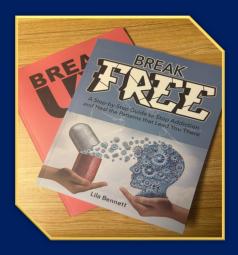

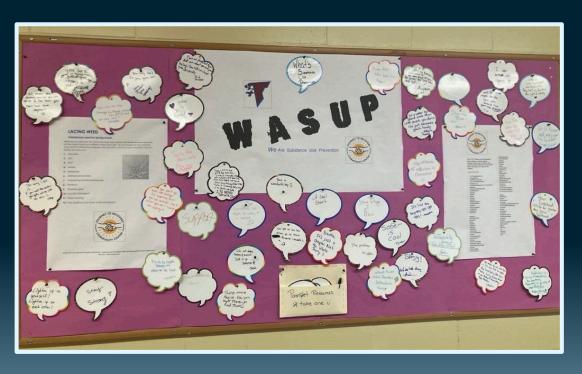

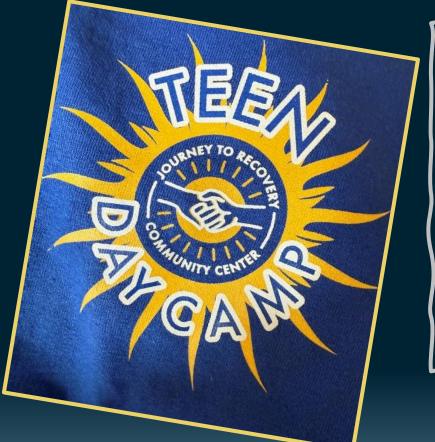












Survival Skills Day Camp for youth ages 12-15 and 16-18- weekly sessions. June through August.
